	Absences and Excuses
	State law establishes conditions under which any child may be excused from attendance at school. In keeping with these statutes and recommendations of the State Department of Education, pupils in the Garnet Valley Schools may be excused temporarily from school attendance for the following reasons: sickness, quarantine, recovery from accident, required court attendance, death in family, family educational trips, educational tours and trips.
	Parents/guardians shall provide an explanation for the absences of a child. These shall be required in advance for types of absences where advance notice is possible. In instances where the school administration believes that absences due to illness are chronic or irregular, the school administration may request a physician's statement certifying that such absences are medically justifiable.
	Three consecutive days of absence will require a doctor's note. A doctor's note will also be required if a student's absences exceed 10. In order to be excused, absences must be reported within three days.
	Absences can be reported through SchoolMessenger's SafeArrival reporting system by phone: 877-638-1960, the mobile app, or through the SafeArrival website (login is necessary).
